**NZ Fire Service** are calling for Waitarere volunteers for the beach station. The Waitarere Beach brigade responds to an average of 60 emergency callouts a year, about one a week. The Waitarere brigade often assists crews from Foxton, Levin and farther afield in responding to fires, car accidents, natural disasters, medical emergencies, hazardous material events, and yes even cats stuck up a tree. ## Defibrillators

Waitarere Beach Community has a new defibrillator sited at 4 square available 24/7, with thanks to Waitarere Fishing Club, Lewis Farms, Graeme Bagrie and Easton Family and Frank Taylor (for site). **Call 111 for instruction on how to access the defibrillator.**



NB: There are several defibrillators distributed throughout the Village – sites include Surf Club (during patrol hours), Waitarere Fire Station (by calling 111) Hyderabad Holiday Park (Forest Road) Waitarere Club (Park Ave - Club opening hours).

## Reminders.

**Community Security Cameras** – It is IMPORTANT to remind the Police that we have cameras located at Waitarere Beach, if you need to report any crime where images may have been recorded by the community security cameras.

**Rubbish** - Please use the HDC bins that have been provided around the beach. Keep our Beach & Village litter free. Recycle Bins by the surf club - Please do not overfill.

**Beach Clean-up** - Dates for the Next 4 months- **11am start** - Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April, Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> May, Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June & Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> July.

**Vehicles on the beach.** All Vehicles need to be registered. Keep to the **30kmph speed limit** when driving cars and/or on your quad or motorbikes. If you witness bad driving or accidents etc, please contact NZ Police on 111 for urgent/dangerous or 105 for non-urgent.
